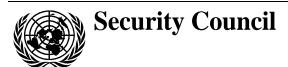

Letter dated 29 April 2002 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1171 (1998), adopted by the Security Council on 5 June 1998, concerning Sierra Leone. In paragraph 4 of that resolution, the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone was required to report to the Council on notifications received from States on the export of arms and related materiel to Sierra Leone, as well as on notifications of imports of arms and related materiel made by the Government of Sierra Leone.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that the Committee received a notification, on 23 April 2002, from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland concerning the export of the following armoured vehicles for deployment with Ghana Armed Forces-United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL):

- Two TACTICA armoured personnel carriers (10-seater with turret (day/day sight) (licence item No. 1 CUM 2/2))
- One TACTICA armoured personnel carrier (10-seater with turret (day/night sight) (licence item No. 2 CUM 1/1))

The shipment was scheduled to arrive for discharge at Tema, Ghana, around 13 March 2002.
