Citation. 1. These Rules may be cited as the Arms and Explosives (Arms) Rules.

# POSSESSION

Application for a b licence.

2. Every application for a licence shall be in writing signed by the applicant, and shall be made to the licensing authority.

Form of licence to possess arms.

3. A licence for possession of an arm shall be in the Form A set out in the Schedule.

Expiry of licence.

4.—(1) The licence for the possession of an arm shall expire 24 months after the date of issue.

- (2) Where a licensee in possession of one arm subsequently acquires another arm or other arms, a licence for any such arm subsequently acquired shall expire on the same date as that for the first arm.
- 5. The licensing authority shall keep a register in his office Register to in which shall be entered the following particulars of all guns and arms for which he has issued possession licences:

licensing

- (a) date of issue of licence;
- (b) name of licensee;
- (c) address of licensee;
- (d) nature of the guns and arms licensed;
- (e) identification marks; and
- (f) particulars of any condition under which the licence has been granted.
- 6. The licensing authority shall cause an indelible dis- Mark to be tinguishing mark to be placed on every gun or arm for which he issues a possession licence and which is not already indelibly every gun or arm. marked with some sufficiently distinguishing mark or number.

**IMPORTATION** 

7.—(1) Every licensed dealer desiring to import guns or Licence to arms shall previously to such importation apply to the licensing import guns authority for a licence to import the guns or arms, and he shall deliver to the licensing authority a correct list stating

- (a) the number:
- (b) the description;
- (c) calibre of the guns or arms he desires to import;
- (d) name of the manufacturer of such guns or arms;
- (e) name of the vessel in which they are being imported;
- (f) the probable date of her arrival; and
- (g) whether such guns or arms are for stock or tranship-
- (2) Any person giving false information as to any of these matters shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 unless he shall prove that he did not know or had not the means of knowing that any such information was false.
- 8. Any person other than a licensed dealer desiring to Licence to import guns or arms shall without unnecessary delay apply to the import by licensing authority for a licence permitting the importation and licensed shall in addition to the first 6 particulars required to be stated dealer.

under rule 7 (1), state the name of the person for whose use they are being imported and whether they are to be kept in Singapore or sent elsewhere. A person who contravenes this rule shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$25.

Form of licence to import.

9. The licence to import shall be in the Form B set out in the Schedule and shall remain in force for a period of 7 days from the date of the landing or removal of such guns or arms from the vessel or other mode of conveyance concerned.

Application for permit to land.

The application under section 17 of the Act for a permit to land or to land for the purpose of transhipment or to tranship without landing any guns or arms on board of any vessel arriving at any port shall be in writing signed by the applicant. The permit shall be in the Form C set out in the Schedule and shall contain the particulars required therein. If this permit is not made use of within 48 hours from the hour of issue it shall be returned to the licensing authority under a penalty not exceeding \$50.

#### **EXPORTATION**

**Particulars** exportation.

- 11.—(1) Every person desirous of exporting guns, arms, or required for naval or military stores shall deliver to the licensing authority a list showing
  - (a) the nature;
  - (b) calibre and number of guns or arms;
  - (c) description and quantity of such naval or military stores;
  - (d) the country of destination;
  - (e) the name of the ship in which it is intended to export the same; and
  - (f) the probable date of sailing.
  - (2) Any person who contravenes any of the requirements of this rule shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.

Form of licence to export.

12. On receiving the above particulars the licensing authority shall, subject to the terms of any notification made under section 4 of the Act and any conditions which may from time to time be imposed in respect of the export of guns or arms to other countries, issue a licence to export in the Form D set out in the Schedule. Such licence shall remain in force for a period of 7 days from the date of issue.

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## MANUFACTURE, ETC.

13.—(1) A licence to manufacture, deal in, or repair guns or Form of arms shall, with such modifications as the circumstances require, be in the Form E set out in the Schedule.

ture.

- (2) Every such licence shall be limited to the manufacture, dealing in or repair of, as the case may be, such guns or arms or types thereof as may be specified therein. The licence shall be valid for a period of two years and shall expire at the end of January, February or March, as may be specified therein.
- 14. Every person licensed to manufacture or deal in guns stock and and arms shall keep a stock and sales book which shall be open to sales book. the inspection of the licensing authority or any officer deputed by him for the purpose during business hours. Such person shall on demand furnish the licensing authority or the person deputed by him with copies of any entries which he may be required to supply.

15. The stock book shall show —

**Particulars** entered in stock

- (a) the date on which any guns or arms are taken into stock;
- (b) the number of the import licence (if the guns or arms have been imported) or the name of the person from whom purchased or received;
- (c) the description of the guns or arms;
- (d) numbers of each description taken into stock;
- (e) the date of sale of any guns or arms;
- (f) the number of the purchase licence or export licence;
- (g) the quantity of each description of guns or arms sold or exported.
- Any person who contravenes rules 14 and 15 shall be Penalty guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not under rules exceeding \$250.
- The licensing authority shall keep a book to be called Licensing the stock book in which he shall enter -

authority to

- (a) the names of all persons licensed to manufacture or book. deal in guns or arms;
- (b) date on which guns or arms are taken into stock;
- (c) number and date of import licence;
- (d) number and description of guns and arms;
- (e) date of sale;

- (f) number and date of licence;
- (g) number and description of guns and arms sold;
- (h) name; and
- (i) address of purchaser.

Books to be balanced monthly.

18. The stock and sales book and the licensing authority's stock book shall be balanced monthly and the stocks of each licensed dealer shall be checked at least once in each quarter by the licensing authority or by an officer deputed by him.

Licence to be displayed. 19. Every person to whom a licence to manufacture, deal in, or repair guns and arms shall have been issued, shall keep affixed to the outside of his premises a board to be approved of by the licensing authority containing the licensee's name, and the words "Licensed to manufacture or deal in, or repair (as the case may be) guns or arms".

Penalty under rule 19. 20. Any person who contravenes rule 19 shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$25.

Stock to be kept in secure place.

- 21.—(1) Every person licensed to manufacture, deal in, or repair guns or arms shall keep his entire stock within the place or places described on his licence and in no other place, and such place shall be of sufficient security to the satisfaction of the licensing authority and shall be open to the inspection of the licensing authority or any officer deputed by him, during business hours.
- (2) Any person who contravenes this rule shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.

Records to be kept by persons licensed to repair guns or arms.

- 22.—(1) A person who is licensed to repair guns or arms shall keep a book which shall be open to the inspection of the licensing authority or an officer deputed by him, in which he shall enter
  - (a) the date on which any gun or arm is received by him for repair;
  - (b) the name;
  - (c) the address of the person from whom received;
  - (d) the description of gun or arm; and
  - (e) the date on which the gun or arm was returned.
- (2) Any person who contravenes this rule shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$25.

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### **PURCHASE**

A licence to purchase arms shall be in the Form F set Form of out in the Schedule and shall remain in force for one month from the date of issue.

24. Every licensed dealer shall on the first day of every Licensed month forward to the licensing authority all licences to purchase dealer to received by him during the previous month under a penalty not licences to exceeding \$10 for every licence not so forwarded, and these purchase licences shall be checked by comparison with the books kept by the licensing authority the licensing authority.

25. The licensing authority may subject to the approval of Forfeited the Commissioner of Police order the destruction or sale of any gun or arm gun or arm forfeited under the Act and any moneys derived from destroyed the sale of such forfeited gun or arm shall be paid into the or sold. The licensing authority shall keep a register of all guns Register of forfeited or arms forfeited under the Act showing guns or

(a) date of forfeiture;

(b) reason for forfeiture;

- (c) manner of disposal;
- (d) date of disposal;
- (e) amount realised by sale (if sold); and
- (f) date of payment into the Consolidated Fund.

27.—(1) The fees to be charged for licences under these Fees. Rules shall be as follows:

(a) for a licence to possess a fire-

\$300 for 2 years or part thereof

(b) for a licence to possess an air gun or pistol or any arm the propelling force of the projectile in which is other than an explosive

\$100 for 2 years or part thereof

(c) for a licence to possess a shot gun, rifle, revolver or pistol belonging to a member of a shooting club which has been duly registered or exempted from registration and which is used for target practice

\$100 for 2 years or part thereof

(d) for a licence to possess an arm used solely for the lawful destruction of wild animals and vermin in any plantation or garden, which arm shall not be removed from such plantation or garden without a permit from the licensing authority	\$120 for 2 years or part thereof
(e) for a licence for a theatrical or circus company to possess any number of arms for its bona fide use at any performance to be given by such company	\$20 a year or part thereof
(f) for a licence to purchase arms or guns	\$10 for each purchase
(g) for a licence to import or export arms or guns	\$10 for each consignment
(h) for a licence to manufacture or deal in arms and guns	\$1,100 for 2 years or part thereof
(i) for a licence to deal only in bayonets, swords, daggers, spears and spearheads	\$300 for 2 years or part thereof
(j) for a licence to possess bayonets, swords, daggers, spears and spearheads	\$10 a year or part thereof
(k) for a licence to repair arms and guns	\$300 a year or part thereof

(1) For a duplicate of any licence lost or destroyed ... \$5.

(2) The Permanent Secretary may in his discretion remit wholly or in part any of the fees chargeable under paragraph (1).

of 3 months from the date of expiration thereof unless the licensee proves to the satisfaction of the licensing authority that he has not resided in Singapore at any time during that period, or unless the licensing authority has received from the licensee not later than 14 days after the expiration of his licence, a written notification of some reasonable cause which prevents the licensee from renewing his licence.

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28. The licensing authority may refuse to renew a licence if Renewal of application for its renewal has not been received within a period licence.
